Venue	<p>The venue for the conference will be the University of Vienna. The conference will use the main building of the University and two buildings located in immediate vicinity to the main building: the Kolingasse building (recently acquired by the University of Vienna) and the Juridicum.</p> <p>The university was founded in 1365 and is the largest university in Central Europe. It is located within Vienna's historic center, directly on Vienna's famous Ringstrasse Boulevard. The planned conference location is easy to reach from anywhere in the city</p>

	The location and the layout of the University of Vienna is a perfect place for scientific work and also for an appreciable social program.
Accommodations	Many hotels at every different price point are located in the center of the city where the conference will be held.

Accessibility	The direct flight time to Vienna from any European capital does not exceed 3 hours and Vienna is also easily reachable with direct flights from North and South America and from Asia. The airport of Vienna is a major hub of Austrian Airlines for many connections to Eastern Europe and to Asia. There are no restrictions whatsoever for citizens of any country of the world to enter Austria
Transportation	The conference will supply a free ticket usable during the entire meeting for public transportation anywhere in Vienna.
Wow Factor	Vienna has established an outstanding reputation as conference city. After 8 years being the number 1 destination worldwide for association meetings (Source: Internationals Congress & Convention Association statistics 2005–2012), Vienna was ranked 2nd in 2018. Sites in the city: From Gothic St. Stephen’s Cathedral to the Imperial Palace to the Art Nouveau splendor of the Secession, from the magnificent baroque palace Sch.nbrunn to the Museum of Fine Arts to modern architecture at the MuseumsQuartier. Record-breaking: In Vienna, there are over 27 castles and more than 150 palaces and nd over 100 museums. Vienna is renowned as the world’s capital of music. It has been home Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, to the “Waltz King” Johann Strauss, Franz Schubert, Haydn, Beethoven, Brahms, Schoenberg and Mahler. Each year the Vienna concert schedule includes more than 15,000 events of various sizes and genres.
