

DECLARATION

On behalf of the Ecuadorian Mathematical Society (Sociedad Ecuatoriana de Matemáticas, SEdeM), and in compliance with the requirements established for membership in the International Federation of Operational Research Societies, I hereby certify the following:

(i) Objectives of the Society

The Ecuadorian Mathematical Society (SEdeM) is a non-profit scientific association whose objectives are to promote the advancement of pure mathematics, applied mathematics, and operations research in Ecuador; to foster research, education, and dissemination of mathematical knowledge and its applications; to strengthen collaboration among academics in Ecuador and abroad in fields related to mathematics, mathematical modeling and operations research; and to contribute to the application of mathematical modeling and methods in diverse sectors of society.

(ii) Conditions of Membership

Membership in SEdeM is based solely on scientific and professional qualifications, as determined by the statutes of the Society. Membership and its associated privileges are in no way restricted by race, religion, color, national origin, sex, or political preference.

(iii) Officers and Governing Body

The governing body of SEdeM (Board of Directors) consists of the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and four Members-at-Large with their respective alternate members. The current officers and members of the Board of Directors, together with their contact addresses and terms of office, are provided in Annex 1 to this declaration.

(iv) Election Procedures

Officers and members of the governing body are elected from closed lists by the General Assembly of members, following democratic procedures as described in the statutes of SEdeM.

(v) Membership Qualifications and Fees

Membership in SEdeM is open to individuals with academic or professional qualifications in mathematics or related disciplines. Categories of membership, annual fees, and other relevant conditions are described in the statutes of the Society. A summary of these provisions is provided in Annex 2.

(vi) Meetings and Publications

SEdeM convenes a General Assembly of members at least once per year, and organizes scientific meetings, workshops, and conferences on a regular basis. The Society also supports the publication of proceedings, reports, and other materials that contribute to the dissemination of mathematical knowledge in Ecuador.
